Beginning Sunday, October 18, FLC will be open for indoor worship at both the 8:30 am and 10:30 am service times.

Due to Minnesota's Covid-19 regulations, we will be operating at 50% capacity indoors. The


sanctuary space is limited, which is why we are encouraging you to register ahead of time and as soon as possible.

# INDOOR WORSHIP FAQ

#### PLEASE REVIEW THE INFORMATION BELOW PRIOR TO WORSHIP

Public Health Guidelines as shared by the CDC and the Minnesota Department of Health will be followed for all On-Campus Events. Please arrive 15 minutes early to allow time to be seated while staying socially distanced.

- Masks are required. We will have face masks available if needed.
- Please remain six feet apart from others not in your particular group.
- Please pay attention to the signs with directions on which doors to use for entering and exiting.
- A drop box will be available for you to drop off your offerings as you arrive or leave worship.
- Bathrooms will be available, however we ask that you only use them in the case of emergency.

# BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

We ask that you DO NOT attend worship if you answer "yes" to any of these questions:

- Have you been diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last month?
- Have you had close contact with someone diagnosed with Covid-19 in the last 2 weeks
- Have you developed any of the following symptoms in the last 2 weeks?
  - New or worsening cough or shortness of breath?
  - Sore throat?
  - New loss of sense of smell or taste?
  - Do you have a fever of 100.4 degrees or more and/or have you taken medication to reduce a fever in the last 24 hours?
  - Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea?



### FALL PROGRAMMING MOVES INDOORS

Beginning the week of October 18, Sunday FLCTIME, Wednesday FLCTIME, Confirmation, KOIN and adult music will start to move indoors.

Please know we are working hard to keep our congregation safe during this time. CDC and Minnesota Department of Health Guidelines are being followed. Please be patient with us as we navigate through this transition.

Children's and Youth programming at FLC follows the Farmington School District schedule. In the event that Farmington School District transitions to distance learning, FLC'S program will also be virtual.

When you arrive back at FLC you will notice signs that designate entrances and exits as well as reminders to socially distance. Please do your best to continue to keep 6 feet between you and your neighbor.

All classrooms, music rooms and meeting spaces will be marked with COVID-19 capacities. Please do your best to adhere to this restrictions.

As we get closer to the 18th, you will be getting more detailed information from our program directors. Please be sure to check your emails and share any thoughts, ideas, or concerns you may have.

Masks will be required at all indoor and outdoor events at FLC. If you forget your mask, or need one, we can provide one for you.
