MOVING MOUNTAINS

Thank you for all who have been a part of the "Moving Mountains" Stewardship Appeal.

Your giving and returned Statements of Intent are important as we plan to strengthen ministries by sustaining the addition of Pastor Ben and Pastor Kristen Eisele.

- Over 150 households have returned Statements of Intent.
- 30 new households completed a Statement of Intent this year.
- 72 households showed an intent to increase their giving in 2022.
- 34 households intend to sustain their current level of giving in 2022.

Your returned Statements of Intent to date show an estimated increase in giving to the general fund of \$41,029. Thank you!

FACEMASK UPDATE

As the number of COVID-19 cases continue to rise, FLC's Reopening Strategy Team continues to make decisions based on the guidance of the CDC and Minnesota Department of Health.

As we hear those who work in hospitals asking for support as they care for such a high number of COVID patients and lack room for patients who need care, we will continue to recommend all worshippers wear facemasks while in the building.

Children's and youth programming will resume in the new year, and while the school district is moving to optional masks at that time, FLC will continue to require masks for everyone during programming times for youth age 3 through 8th grade on Wednesday evenings and during Sunday FLCTime.




UPCOMING ADULT EDUCATION
