What is Love? This is our theme for Lent and there are so many ways we could answer this question. Love is central to our most important call as Christians. As Mark tells us in chapter 12, our first commandment is to love God with all our heart, mind, soul and strength and the second commandment is to love our neighbor as ourselves. (29–31)

Sometimes it is really easy to love someone else. When someone is kind, giving and loving toward us it is easy to love that person. When someone is similar to us and we understand them and see and experience the world in similar ways, it is easy to love them.

But when someone is not kind or loving, or when we do not see the world the same way that they do, it can be really hard to love them. But, again, that is what we are called to do.

During this season of Lent, we will explore ways in which the hard work of loving the neighbor can be done. We'll talk about humility, listening, begin uncomfortable, telling the truth and healing. Together we will explore what it means to love God and to love our neighbor.

# NEW GIVING AT FLC

We are so excited to share that we are transitioning all of our online giving at FLC over to a new platform – Tithe.ly! This transition will allow us to combine our giving records, church database, registrations, volunteer sign up and more all in ONE PLACE!

In order to make this transition smooth, we need your help!

The first step will be to discontinue your current recurring giving through SimplyGiving. If you would like for our office to discontinue this recurring payment for you, please send us an email or give us a call to let us know and we will take care of that for you. Otherwise, you can do that by following this link: SimplyGiving. After you log in you will see "My Scheduled Transactions". To the right of your recurring giving you will see a "delete" option. Choose the "delete" option to

discontinue future recurring giving payments. Please know that scheduled withdrawals begin processing on Tuesdays each week, with a withdrawal date on Thursdays. Please schedule your new giving accordingly to avoid double withdrawals.

The next step is to register on Tithe.ly. It only takes a few minutes to set up, and has the option to use either a bank account, credit card or Google Pay. You can find that link here:





# PREPAREDNESS IN THE LONGER DAYS

Lent means longer days, the ground is getting softer, even ground still hidden under snow. Lent means something is changing, and our priorities will change too, sometimes whether we like it or not. Soon the weather rollercoaster will begin for farmers: they will need to be ready to plant on the days when they can plant and willing to wait on the days when the weather does not wish to cooperate. Lent is the season of preparing. Readying ourselves for what is to come, even when we cannot always see clearly what it is that is coming.

The season of Lent is accompanied by the lengthening of the days. Opening windows, letting in life and death, the things we cannot control. It means going to the cemetery and standing in the mud and snow and grass, where the pain and the hope are mixed together. It is a time of waiting and preparing.

The work of a pastor and church during Lent - Holy Week is

immovable, even if you have three funerals the same week. What Must Get Done, and what is simply Elective becomes crystal clear. Priorities change. You give things up in order to grieve and rejoice and speak a word of hope to people. You realize, again, that relationships are important, and that, all appearances to the contrary, there is an awful lot of life you have no control over. Preparation is the key to being ready, no matter the circumstances.

Lent leads to spring. The time when hope springs eternal. The time when the Hope of the Resurrection is realized. Are you prepared?

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! By his great mercy he has given us a new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

Romans 12:12 Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer.
