





ABUNDANCE

"I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing." –God's call to Abraham, Genesis 12:2-3

God's call to Abraham in Genesis 12 begins with promises of land, a great name, and blessing. But God also gives the reason for these things. It's not just so that Abraham (and descendants) will receive abundance. It's "so that you will be a blessing." God's promises and gifts are given for everyone's benefit.

In our lives together at Farmington Lutheran, two themes are converging this Lent.

The first is our yearlong theme of "Immeasurably More." We are (slowly, perhaps) recognizing that we're emerging from a time that highlighted shortage and scarcity, rather than abundance. Health, wealth, community, and normalcy were shaken, if not outright taken, these past years. Sometimes it feels like we're waiting for permission to be grateful, or celebrate abundance.

As people of faith, we're called to recognize that we have a God whose promise and blessings are immeasurably more than we could gather and hold ourselves. Furthermore, we're called to take stock of life around us, and look – not just for what's missing, but for blessings. We, too, are blessed to be a blessing. And we're called to share what God has first given us.

The second theme is the Lenten series of "Fed & Sent." Each Wednesday we're highlighting something that we are blessed with; something that "feeds" us – food, community, information, money, and Jesus – and then reflect on how that blessing sends us to bless others.

Our God, who is and offers immeasurably more than we can imagine, feeds us and sends us to feed our neighbors, in lots of ways. This season, you're invited to reflect how you are fed by a grace-full God who provides immeasurably more than we imagine, and moves us to provide for others too.
