You have persevered through the pandemic and you remain filled with hospitality, energy, love, and compassion. Together we are motivated by a deep desire for all people to know the love of Jesus and to have a vibrant faith that transforms lives. Our world needs this love and faith to help light up the path forward now as much as ever! Farmington Lutheran Church is poised for this moment.

We don't pretend to know where, exactly, the path forward leads. Instead, we claim God's promises, and the power of faith to see us through times of uncertainty.

In response to what has been learned through listening surveys and conversations, we have three key initiatives we want to carry out in 2023.

- Nurture Youth with Faith
- Deepen Community Relationships
- Support People Through the Development of Small Groups

The goal of the 2023 Appeal is to fund these initiatives and to sustain other ministries by increasing offerings by \$60,000. A key resource to make these initiatives happen is increasing the shared pastoral role of Pastor Kristen and Pastor Ben from 1.0 to 1.3 FTE.

Please join us for worship on Wednesday, November 23 at 7pm and/or on Sunday, November 27 at 8:30 or 10:30am.


